Access to affordable voice and internet service remains a challenge for many low-income consumers. The federal Lifeline program helps close the gap for these consumers by offering a monthly discount of up

to \$9.25 towards a qualified household's phone or Internet service.

Households with income at or below 135% of the federal poverty guidelines are eligible for the Lifeline program. Consumers enrolled in a government assistance program listed below may qualify for Lifeline as well.

- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- Medicaid
- Federal Public Housing
- Veterans Pension or Survivor's Benefit
